

Misscreate Children's Art Classes- online etiquette

6. Avoid disruptive behavior, such as talking out of turn or making inappropriate comments.
7. Use appropriate language and tone when communicating with the teacher and classmates.
8. Be patient and supportive of others' creative efforts and contributions.
9. Follow any additional guidelines or rules provided by the teacher or the platform hosting the online class.
